## Who can join?

A Leisure Card is available to any resident of the Borough of South Ribble aged 11 years plus and who falls into one of the following categories:

CATEGORY	DOCUMENTS REQUIRED
<b>A) Unemployed</b>	Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) Jobcentre Plus Notification Letter Certificate of Benefit
<b>B) Student in Full Time Education</b> (i.e. at least 15 hrs and not in any paid employment)	Student Certificate (available from the college or university) Letter from the principal Letter from the Headteacher (6th Form)
<b>C) Disabled</b> Residents under 16 years old are eligible within this category	DWP Order Book Incapacity Benefit Attendance Allowance Attendance Allowance Severe Disablement Allowance Industrial Injuries Working Tax Credit (Disabled Worker Element)
<b>D) Carers</b>	<i>Note: If you are in receipt of Disability Living Allowance or Severe Disablement Allowance, then you are entitled to have someone to accompany you to your leisure and recreation activity. There will be no charge for carers except if the carer is using the fitness suite equipment then the Leisure Card charge will apply. This concession has an annual cost of £2.00. Carers are able to use the facilities in their own right. Carers must be registered with Carers Lancashire prior to use of the facilities. For more information, please Tel 0345 688 7113.</i>
<b>E) Aged 60 years and not in full-time employment</b>	Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) The Pensions Service Pension Card State Pension Order Book Bus Pass Bank Statement showing: DWP state pension credit, or Works retirement pension, Birth certificate plus letter confirming retirement.
<b>F) On a low income</b>	Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) Order book Working Tax Credit NB Income Support NOT Children's Tax Credit
<b>G) In receipt of Housing Benefit</b>	Entitlement Letter from South Ribble Borough Council
<b>H) 11-19 Years old</b>	Birth certificate
<b>I) Armed Forces</b>	Veterans proof of service and discharge papers

**Note:** (a) Each individual applying for a Leisure Card shall be expected to enclose one of these documents in the appropriate category when enrolling.  
(b) Once issued, the Leisure Card entitles the holder's children under the age of 16 to the same concessions when accompanied by the passport holder. The children to be named on the Leisure Card.  
(c) Leisure Card must be produced for each visit to the Centre.

### How much does the Leisure Card cost?

Categories A, B, D, F, G and H The Leisure Card costs £2.00 for a period of twelve months.

Categories C, E and I The Leisure Card costs £5.00 for a period of three years.

Last or replacement cards cost £2.00 each. The activity charge is available on request at the centres.

### Can I borrow equipment?

All equipment necessary can be borrowed from the Leisure facilities, free of charge.

**NOTE:** to use the fitness suites, you must be inducted prior to use (at the normal induction price.) Junior Fitness Sessions operate in the fitness suites at each leisure facility and customers under the age of 16 years are requested to adhere to these times of access accordingly. For details contact any of the leisure facilities.

### What times are available?

The Leisure Card can be used Monday - Friday from early morning opening until 17.00 at Bamber Bridge Leisure Centre, Leyland Leisure Centre, Penwortham Leisure Centre and South Ribble Tennis and Fitness Centre and all day at weekends. Where applicable, the Leisure Card can be used during ALL Public Swimming sessions.

\*Disabled category users can use the facilities at any time when open to the public.

**NOTE:** Postal applications will be dealt with as appropriate at the Centre.

Whilst the Leisure Card gives you access to the listed activities at the indicated times available, it will not allow admission to centre courses, organised activities or special events.

The information is liable to immediate alterations at the discretion of South Ribble Community Leisure Limited.

### Remember to bring...

1. Completed Application Form.
2. Proof of eligibility (see table opposite).
3. Document with home address (e.g. Driving Licence) or photocopy if postal application. (A personal letter will not suffice).
4. £2.00 or £5.00 (Cheques payable to Serco Leisure Operating Limited).

### Information

If the card holder is playing Squash, Badminton, or Tennis with a non card holder, the person not on the scheme will be responsible for the payment of the full hire charge of the court.
